Junior club rules

Warrington RUFC is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members. The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect encouraged to be open at all times and at an appropriate time to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with your coach or the Chair of Mini's and Junior rugby.

- As a member of Warrington RUFC you are expected to abide by the following junior club rules:
- All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- All members must respect their opponents.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Members must wear suitable kit – gum shields for all training and matches. Appropriate head guards and padding are encouraged. Club kit must be worn for matches, including pre and post match kit as well as playing kit.
- Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
